1. Pharmacy Technician

Reporting directly to the Pharmacist of Record, the pharmacy technician will be responsible for providing end-to-end pharmaceutical duties at BHP Clinical Research Sites (CRS) such as:

- Prepare and complete accountability records for study products and concomitant medications
 to participants and provide counselling on adverse effects and correct use of the products,
 medication.
- Order government antiretroviral drugs from Central Medical Stores (CMS), concomitant and emergency cart medications from government hospital dispensaries to ensure adequate inpharmacy stock levels at all times.
- Maintain appropriate records of receipt, use and disposition of government antiretroviral drugs, concomitant and emergency cart medications.
- Ensure proper storage conditions for in the pharmacy which includes daily temperature checks and response to temperature alerts and incidents.
- Prepare and submit government antiretroviral drugs statistics for CMS ARV monthly reporting
