The HOPE II Study is an individual-level, randomized trial of immediate or delayed vaccination with a single-dose of the nonvalent human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. The study aims to evaluate the efficacy of the HPV vaccination to prevent infection among women living with HIV.

Job Purpose:

The incumbent will be expected to work with the study's Principal Investigator (PI) and Physician Study Coordinator to plan, supervise and oversee the day-to-day clinical activities in accordance with the study protocol and applicable research standards.

Key Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the implementation of the HOPE II study protocol at all participating sites, ensuring ongoing compliance with all applicable HOPE II standard operating procedures (SOPs).
- Contribute to the implementation of the HOPE II study's operational aspects which includes general administration, regulatory aspects, sites set-ups, management and safety reporting.
- Recruit and consent participant, as well as, conduct study visits and administer study
- Provide sexual and reproductive care services to participants in the study.
- Assist with the assessment of data quality assurance procedures, issues related to
- Ensure that study accrual and retention targets are achieved and contribute to contingency plans, as required.
- Contribute to the preparation of accurate, regular and adhoc reports on data, adverse events for the sponsor and governing agencies in accordance with the study's protocol.
- Participate in the training on protocols procedures for team members.
- Identify study specific training needs and consequent provision of training for study staff throughout the course of the study.















Qualifications and experience:

- The incumbent must hold a Degree/Diploma in General Nursing. With at least (2) years of research experience and One (1) year at supervisory level.
